H1N1 Influenza vaccination clinics have been scheduled from November 14 through November 18 at Ridge, West Morris Mendham, and Bernards High Schools. The priority groups for these clinics include:

- ✓ Pregnant women
- ✓ People who live with or care for infants under six months of age
- ✓ Health care and emergency medical service personnel with direct patient contact
- ✓ Children 6 months through 24 years of age
- ✓ Adults 25 years through 64 years of age who have chronic medical conditions

Third Week of Clinics

Saturday Clinic – 9am – 12pm

Weekday Clinics 4pm – 7pm

- *Saturday, November 14 – Ridge High School in Basking Ridge
- *Monday, November 16 – Ridge High School in Basking Ridge
- *Tuesday, November 17 – West Morris Mendham High School in Mendham
- *Wednesday, November 18 – Bernards High School in Bernardsville

- Children under 18 must have a parent/guardian signature on their registration form.
- Clinics are free and open to *only* those who fit the above priority groups.
- Walk-ins will be served *only* if there is extra vaccine available.
- Please check with your health care provider as well for vaccine availability.
- Medical and non-medical volunteers are needed. Call (908) 204-3073.
