Over the last several weeks, the Mendham Borough Police Department has received multiple reports of unemployment claims being filed by the State of New Jersey on behalf of residents and employees of the Borough that were determined to be fraudulent. Unknown entities are filing unemployment insurance claims and residents are receiving the claim notice at their homes. Their employers are also receiving the claim notices.

In the event you receive a notice, please complete a citizen's on-line report. The link can be found on the Mendham Borough Police Department home page. The police department will generate a police report, documenting the fraudulent claim. Also, call the New Jersey Unemployment Fraud Unit at (609) 777-4304. Advise them of the invalid claim. Employers should respond to the notice they receive from the State denying the claim.

Since the claims are being filed against the State, the State of New Jersey Division of Criminal Justice for the Office of the Attorney General has been made aware of the multiple attempts to file claims.
