**RESOLUTION # 144-2023**

**RESOLUTION INSERTING AN ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE 2023 BUDGET AS REQUIRED  
BY N.J.S.A 40A:4-87 CHAPTER 159 (STATE OF NEW JERSEY, DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITIY  
AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES LEAD GRANT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM)**

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services (the “Director”) may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director may also approve the insertion of any item or appropriation for an equal amount.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the Borough of Mendham hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the adopted 2023 Municipal Budget in the sum of \$3,100.00 which is now available as revenue from a grant received from the State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Services Lead Grant Assistance Program; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the sum of \$3,100.00 be made and the same is hereby appropriated in the budget account under the caption “Operations-Excluded from “CAPS” – Public and Private Programs Offset by Revenues – State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Services Lead Grant Assistance Program; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the insertion of the item of revenue is the result of monies being provided to the municipality pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Financial Officer shall forward an electronic certified copy of this resolution to the Office of the Director of Local Government Services as required by law.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
