RESOLUTION #131-2023

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR RESERVATION OF ALLOCATED SEWAGE
CAPACITY OF JOE MISKO REGARDING THE PROPERTY LOCATED
AT 29 HILLTOP RD, BLOCK 1901, LOT 4**

WHEREAS, Joe Misko has applied for reservation of allocated sewage capacity in connection with its proposal to construct a 2 family house located at 29 Hilltop Rd, Block 1901, Lot 4; and

WHEREAS, the requested use of the space complies with the flow restrictions contained in the Borough Ordinance and thus will not result in an increase in the projected or existing sewerage flow generated by the use of the subject property; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer, has reviewed the application, and has recommended the approval of the connection; and

WHEREAS, based upon the information submitted by the applicant under date of September 12, 2023, the Borough Engineer has determined that this application meets the requirements of Chapter 168 of the Borough Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that the aforesaid application be approved, subject to the following conditions of approval: compliance with all applicable subsections of Chapter 168 of the Borough Code and Land Use Board approval, if required; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approval of the application for reservation of allocated sewage capacity is based upon the representations made by the applicant as well as the information contained in the reservation of allocated sewage capacity application; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approval is conditioned upon all plumbing on the premises to comply with all existing provisions of the Plumbing Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that prior to any occupancy of the facility for the proposed use, the applicant must contact the Borough Plumbing Official to schedule an inspection to verify that the compliant fixtures are in place; and

This Resolution shall take effect immediately, but the approval hereby granted shall be subject to revocation if the flow standard as projected is exceeded in actual use or if the Applicant were to violate the applicable sections of the Borough Code.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING AND APPOINTMENT OF DEREK SIMMONS AS
LABORER/DRIVER/OPERATOR IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 10, 2023**

WHEREAS the Borough of Mendham Department of Public Works has a need to hire a Laborer/Driver/Operator due to a recent promotion; and

WHEREAS, after considering all interested and qualified candidates, the Superintendent of Public Works has recommended that Derek Simmons be hired as a Laborer/Driver/Operator in the Department of Public Works with an effective starting date of October 10, 2023, and at the annual salary of Step 1, \$46,595.64 per the Borough adopted Public Works & Water Reclamation Departments Pay Scale; and

WHEREAS, Derek Simmons shall be granted four vacation days for the remainder of 2023 and shall be eligible for those benefits afforded to all regular full-time employees as set forth in the Borough's Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham that Derek Simmons is hereby appointed to the position of Laborer/Driver/Operator in the Department of Public Works with an effective starting date of October 10, 2023, and shall be compensated at an annual salary of Step 1, \$46,595.64 per the Borough adopted Public Works & Water Reclamation Departments Pay Scale, shall be granted four vacation days for the remainder of 2023 and shall be eligible for those benefits afforded to all regular full-time employees as set forth in the Borough's Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual.
